Green Bay Harbor, WI - Cat Island Sediment Placement Site



Project Description

- Navigation Project Served: Green Bay Harbor, Wisconsin
- The facility is owned by Brown County
- The facility is operated and maintained by the Chicago District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
- The Sediment Placement Site only accepts clean material and is about 6,500 feet out from the head of Green Bay, extending from near the Federal navigation channel northwest about 8,000 feet to the shore of Green Bay.
- The Sediment Placement Site has an area of 274 acres, has a total constructed capacity of 2,350,000 cubic yards, and receives about 150,000 cubic yards every other year. The CDF has approximately 5 to 20 years of capacity remaining.

Project Authority

- The facility was constructed in 2013 under the authority of Section 3173 of the Water Resources Development Act of 2007, Public Law 110-114.
