



## Pultneyville Harbor, NY

### Harbor Features

- Located on the south shore of Lake Ontario in the Town of Williamson, Wayne County, NY.
- Authorization: Rivers & Harbor Acts of 1960.
- Shallow draft recreational harbor.
- Project depths are 8 feet in the entrance channel and 6 feet in the harbor basin.
- The harbor was initially protected by East and West Piers. Portions of the lakeward end of each pier were removed in 1933-1934 by USACE. The local community reconstructed approximately 300 feet of the landward end of the West Pier in 2021 with Section 408 permission from USACE.
- Other features include public transient slips, private slips and launching facilities.
- Major stakeholders: Pultneyville Yacht Club, Pultneyville Fire and Rescue, private marinas, charter fishing interests, and the recreational boating community.

### Project Requirements

- The harbor requires infrequent dredging to maintain the navigation channel. Maintenance dredging is currently required.
- Funding received in 2024 will be used to complete sediment sampling and analysis, and environmental coordination to support future dredging. Subsequent funding will be needed complete maintenance dredging.
- East Pier and West Pier have deteriorated sections and repairs are needed to ensure the entrance channel and shoreline are adequately protected. The East Pier is fully submerged, and portions of the West Pier are below water. The structures provide limited protection and create hazards for recreational boaters utilizing the harbor.



- West Pier repair engineering and design began in 2023 and is scheduled to be completed in 2025.
- East Pier repair engineering and design began in 2024 and is scheduled to be completed in 2025.

### Consequences of Not Maintaining the Project

- Safety issues for recreational boating community and rescue vessels.
- Negative economic impacts, both locally and regionally.

### Transportation Importance

- Located along Lake Ontario between Irondequoit Bay Harbor and Great Sodus Bay Harbor.
- Provides safe harbor for recreational vessels.
- Harbor offers approximately 100 slips and is home to 4 fishing charter boats.
